1A. OUR **REALIZATION** OF CERTAIN FACTS - ROMANS 6:1-10 True, believe it or not! 2A. OUR **RESPONSIBILITY** TO THESE FACTS - ROMANS 6:11-23 - Reckon yourself dead to sin; yield our members to obey

• 3A. OUR RELATIONSHIP TO THE LAW – ROM. 7 (not under law but under grace!) "law" - 523 times; 223 in NT, 148 by Paul of which 78 are in Romans - 23 in ch. 7.

1B. The **ILLUSTRATION** of marriage - 7:1-6

2B. The **INSTRUCTION** of the law - 7:7-14

"What shall we say then?"

1C. The law **Removes** our ignorance of $\sin - 7$ -8; 2C. The law **Resurrects** our sinful desires - 9 3C. The law **Requires** the penalty of death – 10-11; 4C. The law **Reflects** the character of God Himself – 12; 5C. The law **Reminds** us of how terrible $\sin is - 13$; 6C. The law **Reveals** our carnality – 14; 7C. The law **Reinforces** our need of a Savior Read the text!!

- 3B. The IMPOSSIBILITY of keeping the law 7:15-25 The struggle of the Christian life! This passage is brutally honest! We will be looking at four things:
 - ✓ 1C. <u>The Difficulty we have</u> 15, 18b-19; 2C. <u>The Decision we face</u> 16-18a; 3C. The <u>Discovery</u> we make 20-23; 4C. The Deliverance we need 7:24-25
 - ✓ 1C. The Difficulty we have when we come to the Lord, we still have a sin nature 15, 18b-19 Rom 7:15 For what I am doing, I do not understand. For what I will to do, that I do not practice; but what I hate, that I do.
 - Rom 7:18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells; for to will is present with me, but how to perform what is good I do not find.

 Rom 7:19 For the good that I will to do, I do not do; but the evil I will not to do, that I practice.
 - 1D. Our <u>practice does not reveal</u> our <u>values</u> 15 "what I hate, that I do" v. 19 "For the good that I will to do, I do not do; but he evil I will not to do, that I <u>practice</u>" <u>From time to</u> time we can move quickly from being in the Spirit to being carnal!
 - 2D. Our <u>performance does not reveal</u> our <u>desires</u> 18 "for to will is present with me; but how to <u>perform</u> that which is good, I do not find"

Rom 7:16 If, then, I do what I will not to do, I agree with the law that <u>it is good</u>.

Rom 7:17 But now, it is no longer I who do it, but <u>sin that dwells in me</u>.

Rom 7:18a For I know that <u>in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells</u>;

✓ 2C. <u>The Decision we face</u> - 16-18a

- 1D. The principle of the law is validated 16 "it is good" cf. 12, 14; Ecc. 7:20 All sin!
- 2D. The <u>presence of sin is real</u> v. 17 "sin that dwells in me" cf. Psalm 51:5; Isaiah 64:6
- 3D. The power of the flesh is helpless 18a "in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells"

 What do you do when you're alone? cf. Job 14:4; 15:14-16; 25:4-6 cf. Rom. 2:10-12

 \checkmark 3C. The **Discovery we make** - 20-23

Rom 7:20 Now if I do what I will not to do, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells in me.

Rom 7:21 I find then **a law**, that evil is present with me, the one who wills to do good.

Rom 7:22 For <u>I delight</u> in the <u>law of God</u> according to the inward man.

Rom 7:23 But I see another <u>law in my members</u>, <u>warring against the law of my mind</u>, and <u>bringing me into captivity</u> (bondage)to the law of sin which is in my members.

(There are four laws operating in every believer's life)

1D. The law of the FLESH (members) – 7:23a

1E. <u>It battles my mind</u> (all the time!) - 23a - "warring against the law of my mind" cf. <u>Gal.</u> 5:17; <u>1 Pet. 2:11</u> There is a war going on in us!

2E. It <u>brings me into bondage to sin</u> - 23b - "bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members" - cf. <u>2 Tim. 2:25-26</u> - Bitterness is a good example!

Rom 7:18 For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh) nothing good dwells; **for to will is present with me**, but how to perform what is good I do not find.

Rom 7:19 **For the good that I will to do**, I do not do; but the evil I will not to do, that I practice.

2D. The law of the MIND (of believers) -7:23b

1E. It <u>desires to do good</u> – 18 - "for to will is present with me" 19a - "<u>for the good that I</u> will to do" We really do want to do good, don't we? Be sure it is "good" in God's eyes! 2E. It <u>delights in the law of God</u> – 22 - cf. <u>Ps. 1:1-2</u>; <u>19:8-10</u>; <u>40:8</u>; <u>119:16</u>, <u>24</u>, <u>35</u>, <u>47</u>, <u>97</u>, 174

- 3D. The **law of GOD 7:22**
 - 1E. It is **perfect** *Rom. 7:12, 14 cf. Psalm 19:7-10*; *119:137-138, 140*
 - 2E. It is purposeful Psalm 19:11; 119:104, 105, 130
 - 3E. It is **powerful** *Psalm 119:9-11*, *50*, *92*
- 4D. The <u>law of SIN 7:21</u>
 - 1E. It dwells in the believer 17, 20, 21, 23
 - 2E. It dominates the believer 23 "bringing me into captivity" cf. 6:12; 7:11

Rom 7:24 Owretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from this body of death?

Rom 7:25 <u>I thank God--through Jesus Christ our Lord!</u> <u>So then, with the mind I myself serve the law of God, but with the flesh the law of sin.</u>

- ✓ 4C. <u>The Deliverance we need</u> 7:24-25 This intimates the victory that lies ahead in Chapter 8!66
 - 1D. <u>Realize your sinful condition</u> One of the <u>greatest traps</u> of the Devil <u>is to make you think</u> you're better than you really are. "O wretched man that I am!" cf. Psalm 32:3-5; 38:3-10
 - 2D. Respond to the only One who can help you, our Savior, from sin "I thank God through Jesus Christ our Lord!" It's not a process, "how to", but "Who to"! Oh, God help me! Deliver me! Set me free!

Psalm 107:15-16; 116:16-17; 130:1-8

3D. Recognize the facts that reveal your need for the Holy Spirit's power and control! "So then with the mind I myself serve the law of God: but with the flesh the law of sin" Luke 6:10-11; Romans 8:2
