<u>Avoid Divisive Persons</u> 17 Now I urge you, brethren <u>, note those who</u> <u>cause divisions (opposite of unity) and</u> <u>offenses (scandal, snare)</u> , contrary to the doctrine which you learned, and avoid them.	I appeal to you, with deep concern, brethren, ( <u>Rom. 12:1,</u> <u>15:30)</u> to be on your guard. <u>Mark them</u> , concerning <u>those</u> <u>who create dissensions and difficulties and cause divisions</u> , in opposition or contrary to the one or single doctrine, the teaching, which you have been taught. I warn you to turn aside from them, to avoid them. <u>2 Thess. 3:14-15; Titus 3:9-11;</u> <u>Eph. 4:1-3; Rom. 9:33,</u>	We need note and mark them <u>to avoid those</u> who are responsible for divisions, <u>which is opposite of</u> <u>unity</u> , and offenses, scandals, in the church. We <u>need to endeavor to keep the unity of the Spirit</u>
18 For those who are such <u>do not serve our</u> <u>Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly</u> , and <u>by</u> <u>smooth words and flattering speech deceive</u> <u>the hearts</u> of the simple.	For such persons do not serve our Lord Christ but their own appetites and base desires, and by ingratiating and flattering speech, they beguile the hearts of the unsuspecting and simpleminded people. <i>Phil. 3:17-19; 2 Cor. 11:3-4; Col. 2:4-8;</i>	We <u>must not be setting our mind, our</u> <u>motivations, on earthly, material things.</u> We need to also be aware of our methods- <u>not to use</u> <u>smooth, flattering words, which can deceive the</u> <u>hearts</u> of others. Who are we, am I, trying to impress?
19 For your obedience has become known to all. Therefore I am glad on your behalf; but <u>I</u> want you to be wise in what is good, and simple concerning evil.	For while your loyalty and obedience is known to all, so that I rejoice over you, <u>I would have you well versed and wise as</u> to what is good and innocent and guileless as to what is evil. <u>Mt. 10:16; Phil 4:8</u>	The <b><u>purpose of obedience</u></b> is that you <u>be wise in</u> <u>what is good</u> and <u>simple regarding evil</u> .
