And having turned I saw seven golden lampstands, Rev 1:13 and in the midst of the seven lampstands One like the Son of Man, clothed with a garment down to the feet and girded about the chest with a golden band. Rev 1:14 His head and hair were white like wool, as white as snow, and His eyes like a flame of fire; Rev 1:15 His feet were like fine brass, as if refined in a furnace, <u>and His voice as the</u> <u>sound of many waters:</u>	I. Notice two things: Vs. 12-18. THE <u>REVELATION</u> OF OUR RISEN LORD JESUS CHRIST Vs. 19-20. THE <u>RESPONSIBILITY</u> GIVEN TO THE APOSTLE JOHN - 19-20 <u>v. 15b. His MAJESTY (7th characteristic)</u> <u>"and His voice as the sound of many waters" - Cf. Psalm 29:1-11; Jeremiah</u> 25:30-31; Ezekiel 43:2 (quoted here); Hebrews 12:25-26	This revelation of Jesus Christ is totally different from that shown to us in the Gospels. Here we see 12 characteristics of our Savior, Redeemer and King! His Centrality He is in our midst. With us always! His HumanityOne like the Son of Man (84X) His Royalty His garment is down to His feetpossibly clothing of the High Priest His Purity He is the Holy One-"as white as snow"; separate from sinners His Scrutiny His "eyes like a flame of fire". His Victory <u>Is. 63:1-6</u> ; - <u>feet down in Bozrah, then</u> <u>in victory to the Mount of Olives</u> <u>His Majesty</u> There is wonderful peace that comes when we hear and know the voice of God! His voice
Rev 1:16 He had in His right hand seven <u>stars</u> ,	<u>v. 16a. His SOVEREIGNTY - "He had in His right hand seven stars"</u> - cf. <u>1:20; 2:1; 3:1: John 10:27-30; Heb. 1:1-3</u>	will shake the heavens and the earth—the entire universe! <u>Same voice who said, "your sins are</u> <u>forgiven"!</u> <u>His Sovereignty</u> the total of God over everything! His power and control are over all things, all of the time!
<u>out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged</u> <u>sword,</u>	<u>v. 16b. His AUTHORITY</u> - "out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged <u>sword"</u> - Cf. Hebrews 4:12 - (Greek - machalra), but in the book of Revelation, it is the Greek word, , indicating <u>a long and heavy sword</u> - cf. <u>Eph 6:17; Heb. 4:12(machalra);</u> rhomphaia <u>- Rev. 2:12, 16; 19:15, 21; Lk.</u> 2:35; cf. Isaiah 11:4; 2 Thessalonians 2:8	<u>His Authority</u> sword – indicates <u>His judgment</u> and His power—as the conquering Lord and King
<u>and His countenance (face, total appearance) was like the sun shining in its strength.</u>	<u>v. 16c. His BEAUTY - "and His countenance was like the sun shining in</u> its strength" Cf. Malachi 4:2; Matthew 17:2-8; John 8:12; Acts 26:13; <u>Revelation 21:23</u> - The angels are stars; The churches are lampstands; But Jesus Christ is like the SUN!	His BeautyHis face is like the sun at noonday!!! Angels are like stars; the churches are like lampstands, but <u>our Lord is like the sun!</u> God is light!
Rev 1:17 <u>And when I saw Him, I fell at His</u> <u>feet as dead.</u>	v. 17a. Notice John's REACTION to what he saw - "And when I saw Him, <u>I fell at His feet as dead" - Cf.</u> (note responses) - <u>Isaiah 6:1-8; Daniel 8:17;</u> <u>10:8-9</u>	Seeing the exalted Jesus, <u>the response of John was to</u> <u>fall at His feet as dead!</u>
<u>But He laid His right hand on me, saying</u> <u>to me, "Do not be afraid;</u> <u>I am the First and the Last.</u>	v. 17b. Notice the RESPONSE of Jesus - "But He laid His right hand on me, saying to me, 'Do not be afraid' " - Cf. Daniel 10:10- 12; Matthew 17:6- 8; John 14:1; 2 Timothy 1:7 v. 17c. His DEITY - "I am the First and the Last" - Cf. Isaiah 41:4; 44:6; 48:12; Revelation 1:8; 2:8; 21:6; 22:13, 16	The gentle hand of Jesus! He reached out and touched him! What an incredible concept—the <u>awesome, powerful, sovereign Creator, reaches out</u> <u>and touches in comfort. Love, compassion, care!</u> <u>His Deity</u> Jesus is God!!!!
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	<u>v. 18. His ETERNITY -</u> <u>"I am He who lives, and was dead; and, behold I am alive for</u> evermore, Amen, And I have the keys of Hades and Death".	His Eternity
