And I saw a woman <u>sitting</u> <u>on a scarlet beast</u> which was full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.	v. 3 " <u>sitting on a scarlet beast</u> " v. 4 <u>Seen in the position she has</u> – "having seven heads and ten horns"	Rev 12:3 (Satan) - And another sign appeared in heaven: behold, a great, fiery red dragon having <u>seven</u> heads and ten horns, and seven diadems on his heads. Rev 13:1 (The beast from the sea – coming world leader, the "antichrist") - Then I stood on the sand of the sea. And I saw a beast rising up out of the sea, having <u>seven heads and ten horns, and on his horns</u> ten crowns, and on his heads a blasphemous name. Rev 13:11 (The beast from the earth – religious antichrist) - Then I saw another beast coming up out of the earth, and he had <u>two horns like a lamb and</u> <u>spoke like a dragon.</u> Rev 17:7 (The "scarlet beast of chapter 17) - But the angel said to me, "Why did you marvel? I will tell you the mystery of the woman and of the beast that carries her, which has the <u>seven heads and the ten horns.</u>

and <u>adorned with gold and precious stones and</u> <u>pearls,</u>	<i>v. 4 "<u>adorned with gold and precious stones and pearls</u>," - The adornment of this woman - <u>Cf. Rev. 18:16;</u> 1 Tim. 2:9<u>; 1 Peter 3:3-</u> <u>5</u></i>	
having in her hand a golden cup full of abominations and the filthiness of her fornication.	v. 4 " <u>having in her hand a golden cup full of abominations and the filthiness of her fornication.</u> " - The abominations of this woman - ( <i>f. Jeremiah 51:6-8</i> (connects us to ancient Babylon); Examples: <u><i>I Kings 14:22-24</i></u> (Rehoboam's reign-full of sexual perversion); <u><i>2 Kings 21:2, 9</i></u> (Judah under Manasseh- abominations from the nations that God has said to cast out); <u><i>Ezekiel 20:30-31</i></u> (judgment of Judah) <i>cf. <u>Rev. 18:5-6</u></i> 1825 a.d. Pope LEO XII struck a metal with his image on one side, and that of the woman with a golden cup in her right hand on the other side – representing the Roman church. <u>Giant tapestry in the Vatican picturing the Revelation 17 woman holding the golden cup is depicted as the "The Mother Church"</u>	

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### **INTERPRETATION**

<u>THE ASSOCIATION OF THIS WOMAN WITH</u> <u>BABYLON – v. 5</u>	THE ASSOCIATION OF THIS WOMAN WITH BABYLON – v. 5 – She is a mystery associated with ancient Babylon! She is the mother of harlots!	
Rev 17:5 And on her forehead a name was written: <u>MYSTERY</u> ,	v. 5 " <u>MYSTERY</u> " - <u>SHE IS A MYSTERY –</u> <u>This most likely</u> means that the name Babylon is to be interpreted mystically or <u>spiritually</u> - 22 times – <u>Rev. 1:20; 10:7(possibly the whole purpose</u> of God in human history is meant.); 17:5, 7 <u>needing an</u> <u>explanation at once and as affording a clue to what follows</u>	
<u>BABYLON</u> THE GREAT,	<i>v.</i> 5 " <u>BABYLON</u> " - mentioned 286 times - "Bab-el" - gate of God "Babel" – <u>confusion</u> – 2 times - <u>Cf. Genesis 10:8-12; 11:1 -9</u> (v. 7 – "confuse their language") Eastern bank of Euphrates – 20 miles south of Baghdad.	
<u>THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS</u> AND OF THE ABOMINATIONS OF THE EARTH.	<u>v. 5 "THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS</u> " - <u>SHE IS A MOTHER</u> Mythological literature – Sumerian 3 <sup>rd</sup> dynasty of UR – says people once spoke one language until ENKI Sumerian god of wisdom, confounded their speech.	
	ESAGILA: temple of Marduk in Babylon called E-TEMEN-AN- KI – "house of the foundation of heaven and earth" 300 ft. high – two sanctuaries – one at base and one on top. Babylonians believed it was built by the gods.	
	Nimrod's wife, SEMIRAMIS the FIRST ( <u>Gen. 10:8-9; 1 Chron.</u> <u>1:10; Micah 5:6 – Judgment on Israel's enemies</u> ) 1st high priestess of the Babylonian mystery religion; claimed to have a son, TAMMUZ, born in a miraculous fashion, and is the promised deliverer. Diana of the Ephesians "Mother of the gods".	
	TAMMUZ - <u>Ezekiel 8:14 ("greater abominations-women weeping</u> <u>for Tammuz</u> ) - also known as BACCHUS His name - sign of the cross = tau first letter of Tammuz.

QUEEN OF HEAVEN - <u>Jer. 7:18</u> (Jeremiah, do not pray for these peoplechildren gatherfathers kindlewomen make cakes for the queen of heaven): <u>44:11-22</u> (Judah would not listen to Jeremiah-burning incense to the queen of heaven) - <u>Babvlon</u> Her Husband NINUS is also the "SON". <u>Phoenicians</u> - ASHTORETH and TAMMUZ <u>Expptians</u> - ISIS and HORUS (osiris) <u>Grecians</u> - APHRODITE and EROS <u>Italians</u> - VENUS and CUPID <u>Asia</u> - CYBELE and DEOIUS <u>India</u> - ISI and ISUARA <u>Western World</u> - Christmas - YULE DAY Chaldee word for "infant". Easter - ISHTAR - hot cross buns and dyed eggs. Chaldean rites. Religious Babylon Moved to Pergamus (4 <sup>th</sup> century B.C; moved to Rome in 133 B.C.) - the throne of Satan. BEL (Baal) - <u>Isa. 46:1</u> (dead idols and the living God!); Jer. 50:2 (the word of the Lord against Babylon and the Chaldeans); 51:44 MARDUK (Merodach- sun god of Babylon) - Jer. 50:2 <u>("I will punish Bel?</u> ) - Bel is shamed (confounded) = CUSH, father of Nimrod - Merodach. Mother/Child religion developed - the QUEEN OF HEAVEN with a baby in her arms: THE ACCUSATION AGAINST THIS WOMAN - v. 6 <u>v. 6 "drunk with the blood of the saints and with the blood of the</u> <u>martyrs of Jesus." - Cf.
